Data processing aim

Finally, both the personal data of the customers natural persons and of natural persons operating in the name and on behalf of the customers legal persons will be stored in the archives of the Owner and used (according to the art. 130 paragraph 4 Dlgs. 196/2003 and also to the “Provvedimento generale del Garante G.U. n. 1° July , 2008 n ° 188/C, formulation 6, points a, b, c) for the sending of communication concerning products, services, novelty and promotions.

Recipients of the data

The personal data processed by the owner will not be shared, or it will not be given knowledge to indeterminate subjects, in any possible form, including their availability or simple consultation. Instead, they can be communicated to the owner's workers and to some external parties who collaborate with them. They may also be communicated, to the extent necessary, to those subjects who, for the purpose of issuing orders or requests for information and quotes, have to provide goods and/or perform services. Finally, it may be communicated to legitimated persons to access it under legal provisions, regulations and Community legislation. In particular, on the basis of the role job and working tasks carried out, some workers were authorized to process personal data, within the limits of their competence and in accordance with the instructions given to them by the owner.

Transfer of data

The responsible person for data processing shall not transfer personal information to third countries or to international organizations. However, it reserves the right to use cloud services, in which case, the service providers will be selected from those who provide adequate guarantees, as provided for by art. 46 GDPR 679/16

Retention of data

The responsible person for data processing keeps and process the personal data for the time necessary to fulfil the intended purposes. Thereafter, the personal data will be kept, and not further processed, for the time set by the current provisions in civil and fiscal matters.

Rights of the person concerned

With reference to art. 7 of DLGs. 196/2003 and arts. 15 – Right of access, 16-Right of rectification, 17 – Right of cancellation, 18 – Right to limitation of processing, 20 – Right to portability, 21 – Right of opposition, 22 Right of opposition to the automated decision-making process of GDPR 679/16, the person concerned exercises his rights by writing to the responsible person for data processing at the address above, or by e-mail, specifying the object of his request, the right he intends to exercise and attaching a photocopy of an identity document that certifies the legitimacy of the request.

Consent Withdrawal

With reference to art. 23 of DLGs. 196/2003 and art. 6 of the GDPR 679/16, the person concerned may withdraw at any time any consent which he might have given. However, the data processing covered by this statement is lawful and permitted, even in the absence of consent, as necessary for

the execution of a contract of which the person concerned is part of (Goods and services supply relationship).

Complaint Proposition

The person concerned has the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority of the State of residence.

Refusal to data conferment
